Prizes

- The Rang Prize and Zaimis Prize recognise contributions to teaching.
- The Vogt Prize, Vane Medal and Grahame-Smith Prize recognise excellence in research.

Lectureships

The Bill Bowman Prize Lectureship and Dunlop Prize Lectureship support the professional development of early career researchers.

Study awards

- The Schachter Award supports postgraduate students learning a new technique away from their institute.
- The Pickford Award provides up to £10,000 to assist post-doctoral researchers with career-enhancing opportunities.
- The Bülbring Award provides up to £10,000 to help members to access training opportunities following a career break.
- The WDM Paton Historical Research Fund supports the efforts of anyone who is studying some aspect of the history of pharmacology.
